State 911: Steve Hooke – Development Grants submitted, \$15 million in funding, \$34 million requests submitted; awards hopefully by the end of July.

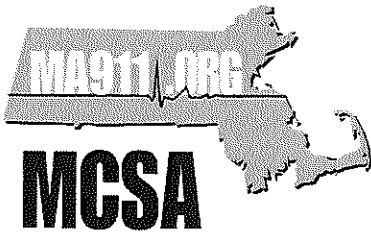

Chris Campbell - Training Grant - Notification of Reduction – Check the State 911 website under Approved Courses for a newly added piece relative to vendors with signed state contracts. Tony Harrison's class invoiced for \$219.00 and was reduced to \$79.00 because of the contract. If 1-10 people sign up on a sliding scale, additional attendees lower the reimbursement. This affects several vendors; state advised vendor should refund the difference. This applies to the Public Safety Group, The Healthy Dispatcher, and certain APCO Classes.
