State 911 Reports – Steve Hooke

- Commission meeting a couple weeks ago, Standards Committee getting back together to review training and NG911 issues; the committee reports issues to the 911 Commission.
- Development Grant approved, increasing funding, \$8 - \$15 million, one time jump, needs ETC approval.
- Development Grants due by May 15, 2018, if interested in a Regional or existing Regional Center, great year to apply, first priority is adding additional towns to existing centers.
- Text to 911 rolled out on Nantucket, coming to Essex, some issues on Nantucket, no date for Essex.
- Chris Ryan – Standards Committee is only for commission members, but meeting is open to the public; only Commission members may sit on the subcommittee. Chris requested notification of meetings, Steve advised he often receives one day's notice, and then meeting is cancelled, with one day's notice of rescheduled meeting. Steve will notify Chris and Don.
- Greg Lynskey advised to reach out to GIS Department regarding your community's compliance; not as daunting as it sounded. Check on your Center and find steps to reach compliance.
- Steve Hooke inquired how we handle EMD and foreign languages with Text to 911; received no answers. Chris Ryan advised it's being addressed in the policy; make EMD attempt.
