June 12, 2024, Annual Meeting - Hybrid meeting held at Galliford's Restaurant, Mendon and via Microsoft Teams. 61 Total Attendees, 54 in person and 7 virtual

1. Welcome and Introductions

- President Erin Hastings called the meeting to order at 10:02am.
- President Hastings informed all attendees that the meeting is being video and audio recorded and will be posted on the website.

- In person attendees introduced themselves.
- President Hastings went over the purpose of MCSA for those who are in attendance and are not familiar with the organization. President Hastings also stated that the number one goal for the upcoming year will be to continue to push the retirement bills. An additional goal will be to continue to grow membership. Lastly, 911 goes to Boston will continue to be a focus. President Hastings asked if anyone else had recommendations for goals. None were heard.

2. Opening of the Annual Election

- Secretary Lynskey announced that the annual election is officially open. He stated that the designated voter for each agency should have received an email with instructions for voting. The email was being auto generated at 10am. If anyone did not receive the email, contact him ASAP. He noted that two candidates withdrew after the May meeting and their withdrawals are noted on the ballot.
- The election will automatically end at 10:45am at which time the results will be announced.

3. Update from State 911 Department

- There was no representative from State 911 Present at the time.
- President Hastings announced the PSAP Leadership Scholarship award winners:

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4. Appointee Reports

- a. SIEC – Corey Swift stated there was no May meeting and the June meeting is scheduled for June 26.
- b. State 911 Commission – Kevin Lessard stated he had officially been appointed yesterday by the Governor. He pointed out that he is the only official dispatch representation on the Commission and that it is an honor to serve. He stated his goal is to represent the mission of the MCSA Board will also representing every PSAP in the state. He stated he had nothing to report from the commission but that the Development Grant awards should be announced soon. He also stated he will work on discussion to add more dispatch representatives to the Commission however this will take time. He stated anything else you want heard, reach out to him.

5. Treasurer's Report

- a. Warren Gould presented his monthly report.
- b. Beginning balance was \$16, 126.64.
- c. Expenses were \$316.01 as follows:
 - i. Microsoft Office 365 monthly \$40.25
 - ii. Siteground webhosting annual \$275.76
- d. Income was \$5,150.00 which was as follows:
 - i. \$5,150.00 FY2024 dues and training payments
- e. The ending balance was \$20,960.63
- f. There were 70 paid members in FY2022. There were 89 paid members in FY2023 which is an increase over both FY2021 and FY2022. FY24 invoices have completely been sent out. Currently there are 77 paid members to date. In total, 100 memberships were sent out. If you have not received your invoice yet, reach out to Warren.
- g. Full Members that renewed this month: None
- h. The following new full members were received: None
- i. The following new corporate members were received this month: None
- j. David Squires made a motion to accept. Second by Khristy Lord. Unanimous vote.
- k. Treasurer Gould stated that currently he is using a laptop from 2017 with a locally installed version of Quickbooks. He stated due to its age, it takes about 15 minutes to get booted up and logged in. He stated he is looking to move to the online version of Quickbooks at \$30 per month which he can then access from any computer. Stephanie Brown asked if



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he was only using it for invoicing. Warren stated yes but moving it to online will allow for credit card payment as well. Stephanie stated she is part of an organization that uses TD Bank and they have free system that is included. Warren stated we could consider that moving forward but that would involve changing banks and we need to do something today. He noted that the current system has all records from 2012 to present which will migrate. Lee Delp made a motion for up to \$100 per month for a computerized based software for the treasurer. Second by Mike Gethin. Unanimous vote.

6. Secretary's Report

- a. Secretary Greg Lynskey stated the May meeting minutes were sent out with the meeting notice and posted on the website. He recommended they be approved as presented. Motion by Kevin Lessard, second by Chris Carleton. Unanimous vote.
- b. Secretary Lynskey stated the 2024-2025 meeting schedule has been finalized and is listed on the agenda.

7. Regional Vice President Reports

- a. Essex – Laura Kilgour stated she had nothing to report. Jim Officer was on remotely but did not provide a report.
- b. Middlesex/Suffolk – Corey Swift and Kevin Lessard both stated they had nothing to report.
- c. Southeast – Brian Kamp stated that Metacomet is looking for a Shift Commander and SEMRECC is hiring as well. He also noted that Westwood Dispatcher John Chisolm has retired after 20 years. Patrick Feeney stated he had nothing to report and offered congratulations to all award nominees.
- d. Worcester – Chris Carleton stated he had nothing to report.
- e. Hampden/Berkshire – Khristy Lord stated they continue to see many agencies in the area hiring. She stated that WESTCOMM will be hosting the Denise Amber Lee Foundation's A Victim's Plea in October. Johnathan Danek stated Wilbraham will be posting this week for 3 full-time dispatchers. He stated their Deputy Director position is expected to be filled internally. He also stated that TERT has an upcoming open enrollment and the Western Mass team is in need of members. He also expressed congratulations to all the award nominees.
- f. Franklin/Hampshire – Dave Squires stated he had nothing to report. He stated he wished to thank everyone for everything over the years as this



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is his last meeting as a Board member. President Hastings thanked him for his commitment and dedication to the Board through the years.

8. Committee Reports

- a. Training & Events Committee – Katrina Shamshak stated a training has been scheduled for October 23 at the Milford State 911 facility. It will be free for members and a small fee for non-members. It will be a discussion based training with Group work. She stated the Annual Training day has been scheduled for March 12 in Foxborough with Adam Timm as the main presenter. It will be the same format as this year with two separate sessions for people to choose from. She is still working on scheduling an ENP class for that day as well.
- b. Newsletter – Katrina stated the June Newsletter is slightly delayed as she was awaiting today's meeting and awards before sending it out. She noted this will be the last one before the summer.
- c. Legislative – Johnathan Danek stated there was nothing new to report. He reached out to Congressman Neal's office but has yet to receive a response.
- d. Emerging Technologies – Rob Verdone was not present and there was no report.
- e. Historical Committee – Butch Garrity was not present and there was no report.
- f. Outreach/Membership – Pete Kinnas stated there 24 nominations for the annual awards culminating in today's award ceremony. He stated it was a good day and great to recognize so many worthy candidates. He thanked the awards committee for their efforts: Corey Swift, Brian Kamp, Erin Hastings, Katrina Shamshak, and Jason Rushford. He also expressed thanks to the Scholarship Committee.
- g. Book Club – Khristy Lord stated the next book has been selected and it is People Driven Leadership by Adam Timm. The first meeting has been scheduled for June 28 late afternoon at the Brimfield Winery.
- h. Peer Support Committee – Khristy Lord stated they had a meeting this week. Anthony Landry from Commonwealth Peer Support met with them. MCSA has decided that the organization's role will be a conduit to get info out about Commonwealth Peer Support and its services. There is an upcoming required training for those who wish to become a team member. It is being held July 29-31 8a-6p in Braintree. The next Committee meeting is scheduled for August 7.



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- i. Generic Training Manual Committee – Corey Swift stated this is going to be a summer project and that part of the October training will be a session to continue work on it.

9. Results of Annual Election

- a. Due to the election still being open, the President's report was taken out of order. Following a recess, the meeting resumed to announce the election results at 10:46am.
- b. Secretary Lynskey stated the election was officially closed and read the results. All positions were uncontested.

- c. President Hastings congratulated all candidates and thanked them for their willingness to serve.

10. President's Report

- a. President Hastings re-appointed Katrina Shamshak as the Training Coordinator for 2024-2025 and thanked her for all of her continued hard work.
- b. President Hastings re-appointed Johnathan Danek as the Public Information Officer for 2024-2025.
- c. President Hastings re-designated all existing committees and committee chairpersons for 2024-2025 as existed in 2023-2024. She asked if anyone had suggestions for any other committees.
- d. President Hastings stated that as a result of only having one candidate for the Franklin and Hampshire County seats that a vacancy will occur. Secretary Lynskey stated as per the bylaws, we are announcing the vacancy and a special election will be held at the September meeting to fill the vacancy. He explained that you do not necessarily need to work in a center that is located in Franklin or Hampshire however if your center



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serves Franklin or Hampshire, you are eligible. Any interested candidates must reach out to President Hastings by August 31.

- e. President Hastings stated a discussion was had at the May meeting for membership fees for the 2024-2025 year. She read the recommendation from the May meeting which was as follows:

- i. \$250.00 for full members
- ii. \$250.00 for corporate members
- iii. \$30.00 for individual members
- iv. \$0.00 for retired members

Corey Swift made a motion to approve recommended. Second by Katrina Shamshak. Lee Delp asked if someone can be an individual members if their agency is a member. The answer was yes, however individual members are non-voting members. The vote was unanimous.

MCSA By Law Proposals for June 12, 2024 Annual Meeting

The following bylaw proposals were reviewed at the May 15, 2024 and voted favorably to forward for a vote at the annual meeting.

Revisions are shown below with underline indicating new language and ~~strikethrough~~ indicating removed language. Full text of each article showing revisions follows.

Article VII: Other Provisions

Section III: Continuity of Operations

NEW Section III Item F as follows:

F. The Secretary, with approval of the President, may appoint assistant secretaries, either on an annual basis or from time to time, to handle the roles of the secretary in their absence. The assistant secretary shall not be a voting member of the Executive Board at any time.

Full Text of revised sections follow

ARTICLE VII: OTHER PROVISIONS

SECTION III: CONTINUITY OF OPERATIONS

- A. In the event the President is temporarily or permanently unable to execute the duties of the President, the Vice President shall be empowered to execute the duties of the President.
- B. In the event the Treasurer is temporarily or permanently unable to execute the duties of the Treasurer, the President shall be empowered to execute the duties of the Treasurer. The Treasurer shall ensure at all times that the President has appropriate access to conduct the organization's financial business with the organization's financial institution.
- C. Notwithstanding the provisions of Article III, Section I, item E, in the event any other officer is temporarily unable to execute the duties of their specific office, the President may, at his/her sole discretion appoint a temporary officer to serve in that office to ensure a continuity of operations.
- D. In the event the President and Vice President are unable to preside over a regular, special, or annual meeting, the President shall designate a meeting officer to preside over the meeting. In the event no designee is named, the Secretary shall preside over the meeting.
- E. All association documents including, but not limited to, organizational bylaws, meeting agendas, meeting minutes, financial records, financial filings, etc. shall be maintained in a central data store to ensure the Executive Board has access to the historical records after officer turnover occurs.
- F. The Secretary, with approval of the President, may appoint assistant secretaries, either on an annual basis or from time to time, to handle the roles of the secretary in their absence. The assistant secretary shall not be a voting member of the Executive Board at any time.
